

ZOTERO

- 1) Go to zotero.org
- 2) Click on "register" in top right corner
- 3) Go to email and click link to direct you back to zotero
- 4) Create a collection in your library.
- 5) Find the "Z" zotero icon in the Firefox toolbar
- 6) Click on "Z" to open up pop-up library
- 7) Click on gear button for drop down menu
- 8) Select preferences
- 9) Add your username and password under the zotero sync server
- 10) Check to make sure the "sync automatically" is selected
- 11) Under "Export" choose whatever style as your Default Output Format
- 12) Go to <https://www.zotero.org/styles> to find styles to install into your zotero library. I've chosen APA 6th edition (annotated bibliography with abstract)

IF we were using zotero and exporting our citations to a word document, then we will right click (control click) on the citation. "Create bibliography from item" and then select our style, whether it's a citation/bibliography, etc.. then copy to clipboard and paste into document.

But! Zotpress does all of that for us, only we are using provided shortcode.

- 13) Start adding sources to collection. Create some annotations in the "abstract" form

ZOTPRESS

- 1.) Go to personal Wordpress blog.
- 2.) Click on Zotpress under your dashboard menu.
- 3.) You will be asked to validate your account
- 4.) Go back to zotero page to make "private key"
- 5.) Settings-feeds/api, give the account some nickname, maybe the same name as your library. Also collect user id from same page.
- 6.) Make sure students can see their collection under "Browse" Show the help page with all the short code
- 7.) Under "Options"- chooses apa or choose style apa-annotated bibliography
- 8.) For apa-annotated bibliography, we'll need to go to Zotero Style repository.
- 9.) Show the "Help" page with all the shortcode.

CREATING BIBLIOGRAPHY

- 1.) Copy/past collection id- this is going to be the first part of the short code.
(find under "browse")
- 2.) Find the "Zotpress Reference" on the right hand side.
- 3.) Select "Style"
- 4.) Select "Sort by" maybe choose "author"
- 5.) Sort order: Ascending
- 6.) "Generate Shortcode"
- 7.) Copy entire blurb into post after our collection id in the brackets. Only need to have the word "zotpress" once or else it won't work

Making bibliographies:

```
[zotpress collection= "ZUZVFQFV" style="apa-annotated-bibliography"
sortby="author" sort=ASC]
```

CREATING IN-TEXT CITATIONS

- 1.) Use "Zotpress Reference"
- 2.) "Type" in-text
- 3.) Search for your individual source you want to use.
- 4.) Select "style"
- 5.) "Generate Shortcode"
- 6.) Paste the first shortcode after your writing.
- 7.) Past the second shortcode at the end of your post with an in-post bibliography. For each source, you will need two separate shortcodes.

Making in-text citations:
