B. GET TO KNOW THE FEATURES OF A WORD PRESS BLOG:

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2. Explore what the DESIGNER sees on the blog – identify the tools that might help you do the above?

- Scroll down to the bottom of the screen and click "Log in." (note: you should see "Howdy [your name]" on the TOP RIGHT side of the screen when you are successfully logged in).
- Click on the $\overline{\mathbb{W}}$ on the $\underline{\mathit{TOP LEFT}}$ of the screen. Then click on the "Dashboard" link.
- Without making changes to the website (i.e. don't <u>update</u>, <u>save</u> or <u>publish</u> anything) → Explore what the links on the left menu seem to help a designer do.
- Which of these features might you need to use in order to write up next week's homework? Why?



1. Get your materials for your Unit Plan Idea POST ready:

- Write your assignment on word or whatever program you regularly use to do your homework. Save a copy.
- Create a folder on your desk top which will have all the materials you need for the blog in it. Create another folder for **images** in that folder.
- Save the photograph you want use in your images folder.

2. Create & Publish the Post

- a. Go to Dashboard → Create Post & Name it --- "Name—unit plan idea" (Put notes on how you did that here):
- b. Add the photograph \rightarrow click Add MEDIA under the title field in order to upload the photograph.
 - Here's the link to the help wiki with more information on how to do that: <u>How to put an image in</u> WordPress.
 - Click on the picture icon in your post to get options for changing the size and position of your picture.
 - Notice how it looks when you stretch or shrink it to size does it still look clear? If it's too grainy and blurry you probably need to find a picture with better resolution (i.e. more pixels aim for about 300 x 300 pixels. Anything bigger takes forever to load. Anything smaller may be too blurry. ask peer, use the help wiki or Sonja if you have questions about this) Also here is the Help Wiki page with information about resizing images: see in particular links at bottom of page to "Digital Image Basics" and "Image File Formats" on this page. Notice information on the difference between resizing a picture & changing the resolution.)
- c. Add a title that describes the essential question of the unit (put the discipline students will work with in parentheses)
- d. **Add text**. Explore the different features on the text edit menu. How can you:
 - add a heading?
 - add bullets or a numbered list?
 - indent
 - add a link to another website?



- e. Save your work by clicking on save draft/update
- f. Add the category that would help someone looking for your work to find it. In this case AUTHOR & your name.
- g. Make your post public (e.g. submit) then hit the green button that says PUBLISH
