

U.S. Geological Survey Internship Learning Contract at the Nisqually National Wildlife Refuge

The USGS is seeking interns for Spring and Summer quarter (with possible extension) to assist in conducting biophysical monitoring for the Nisqually Delta Restoration Project. Interns will get field based experience on the largest estuary restoration project of its kind in the Pacific Northwest. Monitoring is focused on tracking biological and physical changes over time. Possible intern duties will include:

- Bird point counts
- Vegetation surveys
- Invertebrate Sampling
- Water Quality
- Channel cross-sections
- Maintenance of water level loggers
- Measurement of sediment deposition and loss

Internship is for 20 hrs (8 credits) or 40 hrs (16 credits) per week.

Qualifications: Applicants should be working toward a B.S., B.A., or M.S. in environmental science or related field. Previous fieldwork and computer experience is beneficial, but not required. Individuals need a valid driver's license and must have a good driving record.
