The Steward will be responsible for Preserve operations, maintenance and management and will work with other Conservancy staff to develop and maintain key partnerships with neighbors and the local community. The Preserve Steward must be capable of planning, performing, and evaluating diverse tasks including, but not limited to, noxious weed control, volunteer work supervision, visitor management, upland and riparian restoration and monitoring, and a controlled hunting program. The successful candidate will have at least a degree in a science or natural resource management field,



2 years of experience, the ability to work independently, have practical problem-solving skills and strong interpersonal and written communications skills. Experience and qualifications related to prescribed fire, noxious weed control, and community outreach are highly desirable. On site housing and utilities are provided.
