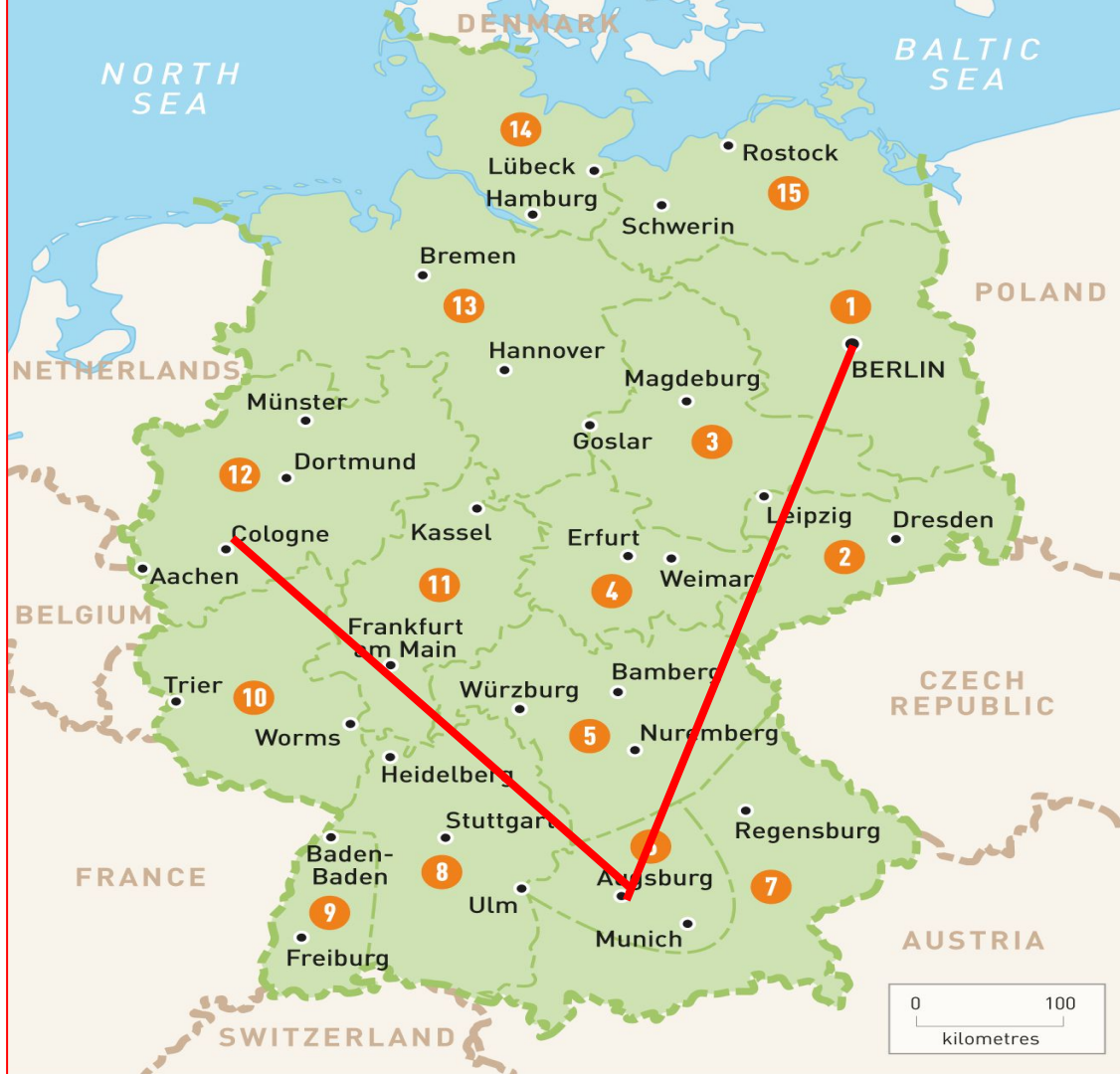


THE HOPPY ADVENTURES OF BEER.
